

VSQG or Very Small Quantity Generator Waste (i.e., wastes from non-household sources such as businesses, schools, farms, churches, etc.) is accepted by appointment only. You can dispose of all those leftover household chemicals, lawn and garden products and automotive materials that you've never known what to do with.

No Empty Containers, Explosives or Ammunition, Medical or Infectious Wastes, or Radioactive Materials (including smoke detectors) will be accepted.
