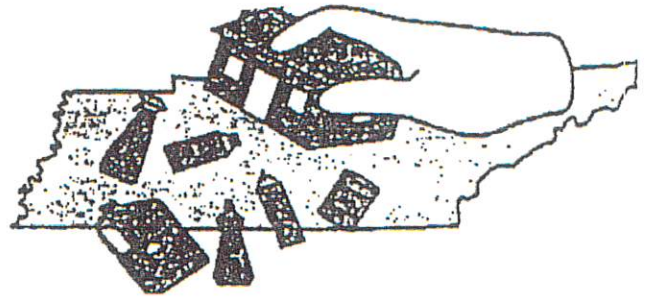

"HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE" is defined as corrosive, flammable, toxic, or reactive materials used in your home, car or truck, garden and lawn.

It's Free...

Any Tennessee resident is allowed to dispose of Household Hazardous Waste. VSQG or Very Small Quantity Generator Waste (i.e., wastes from non-household sources such as businesses, schools, farms, churches, etc.) is accepted by appointment only. Call Clean Harbors at 615-643-3182 to request a price quote and schedule an appointment.

Now's your chance...

You can dispose of all those leftover household chemicals, lawn and garden products and automotive materials that you've never known what to do with.

No Empty Containers, Explosives or Ammunition, Medical or Infectious Wastes, or Radioactive Materials (including smoke detectors) will be accepted.

Paint Thinner

Latex and Oil Based Paint Will Not be accepted*

LAWN & GARDEN PRODUCTS

Herbicides
Pesticides
Fungicides/Wood Preservatives

MISCELLANEOUS

Reactive or Oxidizing Material
Lithium, Button or Rechargeable Batteries
Fingernail Polish Remover
Pool Chemicals
Photo Processing Chemicals
Medicines/Drugs
Aerosols/Compressed Gas

Remember.....Oil based paint is accepted at RASCO Transfer Station and latex paint can be dried up and thrown away in the regular garbage. Also, alkaline batteries are no longer manufactured with mercury and should be thrown away in the trash.
